In recognition that this requires a comprehensive and holistic programme of action if we are to contribute to the **Paris Agreement of keeping the average global temperature below 2 degrees**, achieve the Sustainable Development Goals, particularly **Sustainable Development Goal 11-Bringing about inclusive**, **resilient**, **safe and sustainable urban communities**, and if we are to pursue the **New Urban Agenda**, **that is, rethinking how we plan**, **manage and live in our urban areas**, so that they can serve as engines of prosperity and centres of cultural and social well-being, while protecting the environment and reducing vulnerability to the impacts of hazards and climate change.
